Graduate Research Assistantships are employment with the university under the supervision of a research advisor at a pay rate of \$18 per hour. A research advisor is a faculty member of the university. The main responsibility of a Graduate Research Assistant is to perform research in one of the laboratories of the Computer Science and/or Electrical Engineering graduate programs and to write research papers to publish the results of the research activity at peer-reviewed professional conferences and/or journals. Graduate Research Assistants are expected to select the thesis option of the graduate program.

Graduate Teaching Assistantships are employment with the university under the supervision of an instructor at a pay rate of \$18 per hour. An instructor is a faculty member of the university teaching one or more courses in any given semester. Responsibilities of a Graduate Teaching Assistant consist of aiding an instructor in grading student work, setting up laboratory equipment for courses, and/or answering student questions in the laboratory.

Assistantships, either Teaching or Research, do not include tuition waivers.

To be eligible for assistantships, you must be enrolled full-time (6 units or more) per semester and have a GPA of 3.0 at least.
