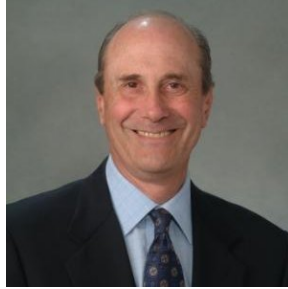


F. Ronald Feinstein, D.M.D., M.D., F.A.C.S.
Brief Biography



Dr. Feinstein served as an Assistant Medical Director at the Kaiser Permanente Medical Center in West L.A. leading the Surgical and Support Departments Service Line's 23 departments. In 2009 the Kaiser West Los Angeles surgical services were selected by The Out-Patient Surgery Magazine for their National O.R. Excellence Award as "First for Patient Safety". In 2007, he was given his medical center's Physicians' Exceptional Contribution Award and in 2011 he was selected as a finalist for the L.A. Business Journal's Healthcare Leadership Special Achievement Award.

He also served for 24 years as both chief of the Department of Plastic & Reconstructive Surgery for the Metro Los Angeles Service Area and as the first Regional Chief of Plastic Surgery for The Southern California Permanente Medical Group's 6500 MDs. As Regional Chief, he led the establishment of six departments of plastic surgery to cover Kaiser's 12 medical centers in Southern California caring for their 4 million members.

He is very active in the teaching of medical students and residents through his affiliation with the Keck School of Medicine of USC where he is a Clinical Professor of Surgery and served on the USC Surgeons Board of Directors.

Dr. Feinstein holds both a dental (DMD) and medical (MD) degree from the now named Rutgers New Jersey Medical and Dental Schools. He completed a residency in general surgery and a fellowship in head and neck surgery at Albert Einstein College of Medicine's Montifiore Medical Center. This was followed by a residency in plastic surgery at the Columbia Presbyterian Medical Center in New York City and later served as the President and Chairman of the Board of The Webster Society, Columbia Presbyterian's plastic surgery Alumni Association.
